Dear Dr. Kelley:

We acknowledge the receipt of your letter dated August 8, 2008, and two copies of the above- referenced report. We have completed our review of the report and offer the following comments.

In general the report meets the Louisiana Division of Archaeology report standards. A few exceptions have been noted and are enclosed in the technical comments. We concur, based on your findings that no historic properties will be affected by the project and no further work is needed for the four proposed well pads, associated access roads and work area. The archaeological site 16EV70, consisting of one positive shovel test with numerous historic artifacts dating to c. 1910 - 1940 is apparently the result of previous ground disturbing activity in the area resulting in the destruction of what is assumed to have been an early twentieth century trash dump.

Please review the enclosed technical comments and photocopied pages with comments or corrections noted. We request that you submit two copies of the final report making adjustments, as appropriate.
